### **H1N1 Vaccinations Available at Immunization Clinics**

**Galveston County and Cities** – The Galveston County Health District is reminding everyone that free H1N1 shots are still available. Beginning Monday, March 8<sup>th</sup> they will be in all of the District's immunization clinics located in Galveston, Texas City and Dickinson.

Everyone is urged to get vaccinated in case there is a third flu wave in the future. If H1N1 influenza activity does increase vaccination is the best protection against contracting the illness.
