TVFC VACCINE (STATE SUPPLIED)

ELIGIBILITY & FEES

Any child who meets at least one of the eligibility criteria listed below and who is 18 years of age or younger qualifies for TVFC vaccines:

- Enrolled in Medicaid
- Does NOT have health insurance
- American Indian
- Alaskan Native
- Underinsured

(Child's current insurance does not cover vaccines, or only covers a select few vaccines.)

TVFC Vaccine Fees:

One Vaccine: \$14

Two or More Vaccines: \$25

Tuberculin Skin Test Fees

\$29

Includes:

- + TB Skin Test: \$20
- + Administration Fee: \$14
- Cash Discount \$5

Adults with no health insurance **qualify** for state supplied vaccines.
